



The Yupik EDC, through collaboration with Jersey Devil Kydex, has multiple carry options. This allows diversity of set ups to serve respective needs with easy access to the knife.

Included with each Yupik EDC are hinged and non-hinged clips. The holes in these clips align with several holes on the Kydex sheath. On the hinged piece are two bars that can be popped out and adjusted.

Changing clip type or position is easily done with a Phillips screw driver.

The **top two knives** show horizontal carry positions, with slightly different hole alignment. These are commonly used on a belt or waistband, termed “scout”.

The **bottom left** and **bottom middle knives** show inverted carry positions. These are commonly used on a backpack shoulder strap, or off cordage around the neck, termed “necker”.

The **bottom right knife** shows vertical carry. This position is used on a belt, bag, or other gear.
